




2013 Water Withdrawal Summary Report



Reported water withdrawals in Ohio are grouped into one of six categories: Public (community and non-community water supplies), Ag/Irrigation (livestock watering, irrigation, golf course irrigation, nursery and landscaping), Industrial (process and cooling water), Power Generation (nuclear, thermoelectric, hydroelectric), Mineral Extraction (coal, oil, limestone, sand and gravel), and Miscellaneous (construction dewatering, amusement parks, fish hatcheries, etc).

Data for these graphs comes from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Water Withdrawal Facility Registration Program, which started in 1990. Section 1521.16 of the Ohio Revised Code requires any owner of a facility, or combination of facilities, with the capacity to withdraw water at a quantity greater than 100,000 gallons per day to register with the ODNR, Division of Soil and Water Resources. Each year registrants report how much water was withdrawn at their facilities.
