

Atlas of Reported* Water Withdrawals within Ohio by County

This atlas presents 2005 water withdrawals for Ohio counties. Water withdrawal is the quantity of water that is withdrawn from a surface water (stream, lake, reservoir) or ground water (aquifer) source. Quantities are reported in millions of gallons per day.
